Summer Transition: Intermediate Foreign Language (6 hours)⁴

While the minimum grade point average is subject to change, the minimum required in this prescribed curriculum for 2004-2005 is 2.75 in the following pre-core business classes: Business 100-101, Business 221-222, Economics 201-202, Mathematics 1810-1820 or 1910-1920, Mathematics 2050, and Written Communications (English 295, 255, or 355).
