

UTK ARTICULATION AGREEMENT SECONDARY EDUCATION

This program leads to an Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science degree from Walters State and a Bachelor of Arts or a Bachelor of Science in Arts and Sciences from the University of Tennessee depending on the chosen major field.

WALTERS STATE

The student should choose one of the programs in this publication which will prepare them to transfer into their major program at UT. The student should complete:

1. Education 2010 (or Educational Psychology 210 at UT).

TEACHING EDUCATION PROGRAM

TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM

Students pursuing elementary or secondary licensure must gain formal admission to the Teacher Education Program in the College of Education, Health and Human Sciences. Students should make arrangements to take a Pre-Professional Skills Test (Praxis:PPST) and a Speech and Hearing screening at UT in the spring of the freshman year or the fall of the sophomore year. (Students who have an ACT score of 22 or 1020 on the SAT total score are not required to take the PPST.)

After attaining a minimum 2.7 grade point average in the first 60 semester hours (75 hours for Secondary Education) of the prescribed curriculum, students may schedule an interview with the College's Board of Admission at UT. Progression decisions, which are made by boards, are competitive, based on available field placements.

After completing a Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Arts degree, with the elementary or secondary education minor, the student will enroll in graduate studies. A one-year internship, along with required testing, is required for full licensure.
