<sup>8</sup>Select six hours from one area: Economics - ECON 312 or 313; 381: Finance - FIN 425, and one of 435, 455, 475, 485: Information Management - IM 341, 342; Logistics - LOG 310, 411; Marketing - MKT 340, 350; Operations Management - OMS 341; and 421 or 441.
