In order to progress into the Social Work major, students must maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.0 in this specified curriculum. To obtain full progression, which occurs prior to the senior year, students must maintain a 2.0 cumulative grade point average with a "C" or better in SW 200, 250, and all junior year social work courses.

All declared Social Work majors with a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.25 are invited to participate in the honors concentration. Freshman and transfer students may enroll in honors courses with permission of the BSSW program director. To graduate with honors, Social Work majors must complete twelve (12) hours of honors work including at least nine (9) hours of social work honors courses. Students completing the honors concentration must take Social Work 467 and complete a senior research project. A grade of B or above must be earned in all honors courses and students must maintain an overall grade point average of 3.25.
